From humble beginnings we have grown to a current enrolment of 339 students. We are highly regarded in our community for excellence in education and care for all in our community.

Thank you for your interest in the fixed term teaching positions we have available. One position is for a Foundation Classroom Position replacing a teacher on long service leave. This position begins on Monday July 24th 2017 (Week 1 Term 3 2017) until Friday September 29th 2017 (end of Week 10 Term 3 2017).

Another position is for a Year 1 Classroom Position replacing a teacher on long service leave. The position begins on Monday October 16th 2017 (Week 1 Term 4 2017) until Friday December 15th 2017 (end of Week 9 Term 4 2017).

Applicants may apply for one or both positions. The successful applicant will be able to fulfil the full range of responsibilities required of their position at St Mark's.

Applicants will demonstrate the ability to maintain the standards of teaching and learning in our school and be able to make a positive contribution as a member of our staff team. A copy of our Teacher Role description is attached.

1. Submit a current CV listing two professional and one pastoral referee.
2. Submit a letter of application clearly addressing the selection criteria below.

Selection Criteria:

1. Demonstrated ability to actively support the ethos of a Lutheran School.
2. Demonstrated ability to plan, implement, assess and evaluate a differentiated teaching and learning program for the relevant curriculum of the position
3. Demonstrated ability to develop warm, caring relationships with students while maintaining a positive, focussed learning environment.
4. Demonstrated levels of flexibility, initiative, perseverance and resourcefulness necessary to contribute to a professional learning community which values teamwork.
5. Demonstrated interpersonal skills that strengthen effective partnerships with parents and staff.
