1. Obtain a satisfactory Department for Human services Working With Children Check (WWCC). The requirement for a WWCC Check replaces the previous DCSI and standard Police Check. To obtain a WWCC check go to www.screening.sa.gov.au and click the applications tab. If you require assistance please contact Leanne in the front office with your **Full Name, DOB & Email address**.
2. Complete the online Responding to Abuse & Neglect volunteer training. This is tailored for volunteers and can be accessed at <http://www.plink.sa.edu.au> (please select the Non- Department training option). You will need a current individual email address to register for a PLINK volunteer account. Please remember to select the volunteer option throughout the process and print a copy of your certificate of completion to present to the office. An instruction sheet to complete the training is attached.
3. Complete Lutheran Education Australia's Valuing Safe Communities (VSC) volunteer training. The training can be accessed at: <http://vscvolanders.lutheran.edu.au>. An instruction sheet to complete the training is also attached.
