Thank you for your interest in the fixed term part time (0.6FTE) classroom teaching position we have available at St Mark's commencing at the start of Term 3 2024. The position is replacing a teacher on leave.

The position commences on Monday, 22nd July 2024 and concludes on Friday, 13th December 2024. The successful applicant will teach a Year 2 class each Monday to Wednesday, continuing an existing job share arrangement.

St Mark's Lutheran School was established in 1982 by the St Mark's Lutheran Church in Mount Barker to provide quality Christian education to our community. From small beginnings we have grown to a current enrolment anticipated to be 336 students. We are community minded and are seeking a passionate educator who has students front and centre, is a learner and collaborator.

The successful applicant will demonstrate the ability to maintain the standards of teaching and learning in our school, reflecting our learning principles, and be able to make a positive contribution as a collaborator and member of our staff team.

Quality teaching at St Mark's aligns with the three domains of *Professional knowledge*, *Professional practice* and *Professional engagement* as described in the AITSL teaching standards.

Applicants are invited to submit:

- A covering letter outlining your reasons for applying for this position.
- A statement **clearly addressing your ability to meet the selection criteria below.**
- A current CV listing two professional and one pastoral referee.

Selection Criteria:

1. A demonstrated understanding of the ethos of St Mark's and ability to connect with and actively engage with and support our ethos.
2. Demonstrated ability to develop quality relationships with students while maintaining a positive, focussed learning environment.
3. Demonstrated knowledge and experience of working with the Australian Curriculum Year 2.
4. An understanding of child development, the diverse needs of students and demonstrated skills in meeting these needs.
5. Demonstrated levels of flexibility, initiative, perseverance, and resourcefulness necessary to contribute to a professional learning community which values collaboration.
6. Demonstrated capacity to reflect critically upon their professional practice.

Educational and Vocational Qualifications:

The successful applicant will:

- Be currently registered by the SA Teachers Registration Board of South Australia as a teacher;
- Hold a current Basic First Aid certificate; and
- Have qualifications or experience commensurate with the role requirements in providing learning and wellbeing appropriate to primary students.
