Jace was selected to represent SA at the School Sports Australia track and field championship which was held in Canberra, at The Institute of Sport.

Jace has been training at Port Adelaide every Saturday morning with the team for the past few months.

Jace competed in the 100m, 200m and 4x100m relay. He recorded a personal best in the 100m coming in as the fastest boy from SA with 13.39sec. In the 200m he ranked as the 13th fastest with a time of 28.22sec. The boys came 5th in their relay with the eastern states (Qld, ACT, NSW and VIC) dominating due to the pathways and athletic academies for their elite athletes.

Jace came away from the championship determined to improve and will work with a sprint coach to develop his technique, power, speed and mind set.
